STEAM FLAKED/ROLLED GRAINS

FOR CATTLE, SHEEP, GOATS, HOGS AND HORSES

Steam flaked/rolled grains are an excellent source of supplemental energy for many livestock. Steam flaking grain is a process that involves steaming the grain prior to rolling it into a flake. This process ensures that the maximal energy yield is obtained from the grains.



STEAMED

The grain is "cooked" in a chamber for 45 minutes with steam to gelatinize the starch (melting of starch crystals)

ROLLED

JUR PROCE

The "cooked" grain is rolled through a corrugated flaker which further increase starch availability

COOLED

Lastly, the steam and heat are removed from the grain as it slowly passes through a larger cooler

- The "cooking" processes increases starch availability of grain significantly compared to ground and dry rolled products
- Improved starch digestibility allows to more energy to be utilized by the animal for growth and performance
- In horses, because the starch is gelatinized, it reduces the risk of digestive upset caused by hindgut fermentation
